Charter of



Massena Public Library.

This instrument witnesseth That the Regents of the University of the State of New York
have granted this charter incorporating

John B. De Vega, Erwin G. Simmons, Coleman R. Cummings, Annie C. Whalen, Mary Snailik Allen

and their successors in office as a free public library in accordance with the vote establishing the same, under the corporate name of Massena Public Library, to be located in the town of Massena, St. Lawrence County, the library to have as provided by law five trustees to be at first the persons named herein as incorporators, who are the duly appointed library trustees of the town of Massena, to hold respectively in the order of their naming as they have determined by lot, one each for a term which shall expire with the official town year in each of the years 1936, 1937, 1938, 1939 and 1940, and their successors to hold for terms of five years beginning with the official town year next following the ending of the term of the trustee to which each, respectively, is to succeed, to be elected in conformity with law, one in each year by the town board of said town of Massena.
